Election and Installation of Two Directors for the PPC Association Board

Using a PowerPoint presentation, John M. Felty, Secretary of PPC Association and Corporate Secretary of SRP, reminded the Members that the Board of Directors of the PPC Association was comprised of up to six members, including four Declarant Directors appointed by the PPC Inc. Board and two Member Directors to be elected by the PPC Association Members. He said that all of the Directors were elected for a one-year term.

He stated that the PPC Association Board had recommended two candidates: Susan Guerra, Chief Operating Officer of the Chesnut Properties LLC (Papago Gateway) and Pam Collins, Director of Property Management at Chamberlain Enterprises. Mr. J.M. Felty called for additional nominations from the floor. With no other nominations being made, nominations were closed.
